E2 Dart League Info

Traditional League Play: For 4 person league play the cost is \$40.00/team/night, trips is \$30.00, doubles is \$20.00, singles is \$10.00, Adult/Youth is \$12.00. Start times are 7:00pm weekdays and 2pm on Sat/Sun. you may start earlier or later, just contact the other team. We will be using the reverse hcp in 01. Schedules/stats/league codes can be accessed on the board or on our website e2darts.com. Last game of doubles is 701 double in double out(not in adult/youth) stacked score, bull is split. If a dart is in between the wire and the segment, however the board counts it is the way it stands. If a dart does not score but is in the board CALL opponent immediately, take a pic to send to them and then tap it in. If a dart bounces or is in the black and doesn't count, hit the red button before pulling your darts. For teams participating from out of town, you will play at home remotely, check to be sure internet is connected. Make sure you set up the board correctly, described below. The shot clock will be utilized, breaks may be taken at your discretion. If a player is unable to complete league play, you may ghost that players turn to finish. If something is not right, call me I will try to fix it. For awards, players must play half the season to receive them. When playing remotely, do not put money in until you have had contact with your opponent (doesn't hurt to contact them a couple hours ahead of time, even with local teams) We are doing cash payouts based on wins Doubles 1.00/win, trips \$1.50/win and 4 man teams will get 2.00/win. Top 3 places will receive an additional \$120/\$80/\$40 for 4 person leagues, \$90/\$60/\$30 for trips and \$60/\$40/\$20 for 2 person leagues, Singles league is \$10/person for sign up, bar matches this with all money going back to the players minus the price of one trophy per division, payouts will be determined by their sign ups. All leagues are handicapped except the singles. When scheduling make up games be sure there is a board available. Communication is key, when rescheduling a match please let me know. Unless it is an emergency, give at least 2 hours notice on cancelling a match. If you know ahead of time you will be out of town, try to play the match early. If a match gets interrupted for any reason, it will save where you were and your money will still be there, just have to finish on the same board. Never cancel a match, your money will be lost. To suspend a match, unplug the board, it will save your league money. I have hot buttons for sale at \$20 each, these are not required for league but come in handy when playing remote casual games to save stats. You can also use hot button to pull game credits off board if you have to suspend. Our seasons generally start in Jan. June and Sept.

<u>Board Set Up</u>: Select 'league play' then 'play league' for playing in person, if playing remotely select 'league play' then 'play remote league' It is very important you select the correct home/away team, refer to schedule for this. Make sure all players have averages and that you select the correct players. Before you throw any darts be sure it is set up correctly, if not back out and start again. In remote play, if there is any issue during a match, pause (down arrow) the game and call the other team immediately to resolve the issue.

<u>Subs:</u> If a sub is not on your original roster, the sub must be similar in average to the player they are replacing. Exceptions can be taken into account, but must be approved by me and the team you

are playing. Starting averages for new players, female 15.0/1.5, male 18.0/1.8. It will be up to the main core team to take care of their subs, ie players pay their subs fees. If a player subs 3 times on a team they cannot sub on another team. You can add subs and their averages at the board, be sure to put in full name so I know who it is. I can also add your subs to save a little time at the board, you will still have to adjust their averages. To do this, select the player, hit the bull and then it gives the options for 01 and cricket to be adjusted. No new subs may be added in the last 2 weeks of league play, including any make ups that might be done in that time frame.

<u>PPD Remote Leagues:</u> These games count towards the TOC and qualify you for the monthly trips and quarterly PPD Nationals remote tournaments. There are league options available 7 days a week with multiple times and flights. There is no sponsor fee for these leagues. If you sign up for one of these leagues and it has NDA symbol next to it, please let me know so I can track the stats. In these leagues, subs pay their own fees and everyone must have a TOC player profile. For more information and the rules for these leagues go to www.dartstoc.com or call me.

<u>Traditional Location Sponsor Fee:</u> The location will pay \$40/team. This money goes towards trophies, pins and shirts. Singles is \$10/person.

NDA Sanction fees are \$10/person and are due in August, this is an annual fee paid to NDA and allows you to play in NDA tournaments and leagues. www.ndadarts.com for info on upcoming events.

<u>Forfeits:</u> When a situation arises and a team must forfeit, the forfeiting team will pay league fees for both teams, this is \$40/match. Emergencies will be taken into consideration. It will be entered as 9/0 win/loss, forfeiting team will get no wins. There will be no money paid out on forfeits. 15 minute forfeit time will be enforced. If you want to practice show up early. Alternate times can be set up, if both teams agree.

<u>Make-Up Games</u>: Include me in text messages when rescheduling/canceling. These need to be scheduled to play within 2 weeks of the regular match. The week after a season ends will also be left open for make-ups. Please let me know at least the day before that you are making up a match, so that I can be available and so I can notify the home bar to be sure a board is available.

<u>Dropped Team:</u> The bar that sponsored said team will still have to pay the sponsor fee. Team that drops will have to pay league fees for that season and will be unable to play another season if not paid. Circumstances beyond anyone's control will be taken into consideration. There will be no money paid out to a team that drops out. The dropped team will be turned into a bye unless a replacement team can be found.

Reaching Players: Watch the ad screen on the boards frequently, I will be using this as a major resource to reach players. Also, E2 Darts is on Facebook, this will be another way to reach everyone in a timely manner.

<u>Thinking Ahead:</u> Vegas NDA Tournament is in April/May, a total of 96 games required, at least 24 being cricket or 01 if you wish to play both. **Sign ups for Vegas are due in Feb.** TOC (tournament of champions) is Oct. each year, minimum of 350 games required, cut off for these games is July 14. Colorado State Tournament is in Jan every year, with 48 game requirement. There are 3 NDA Regional Tournaments each year.
